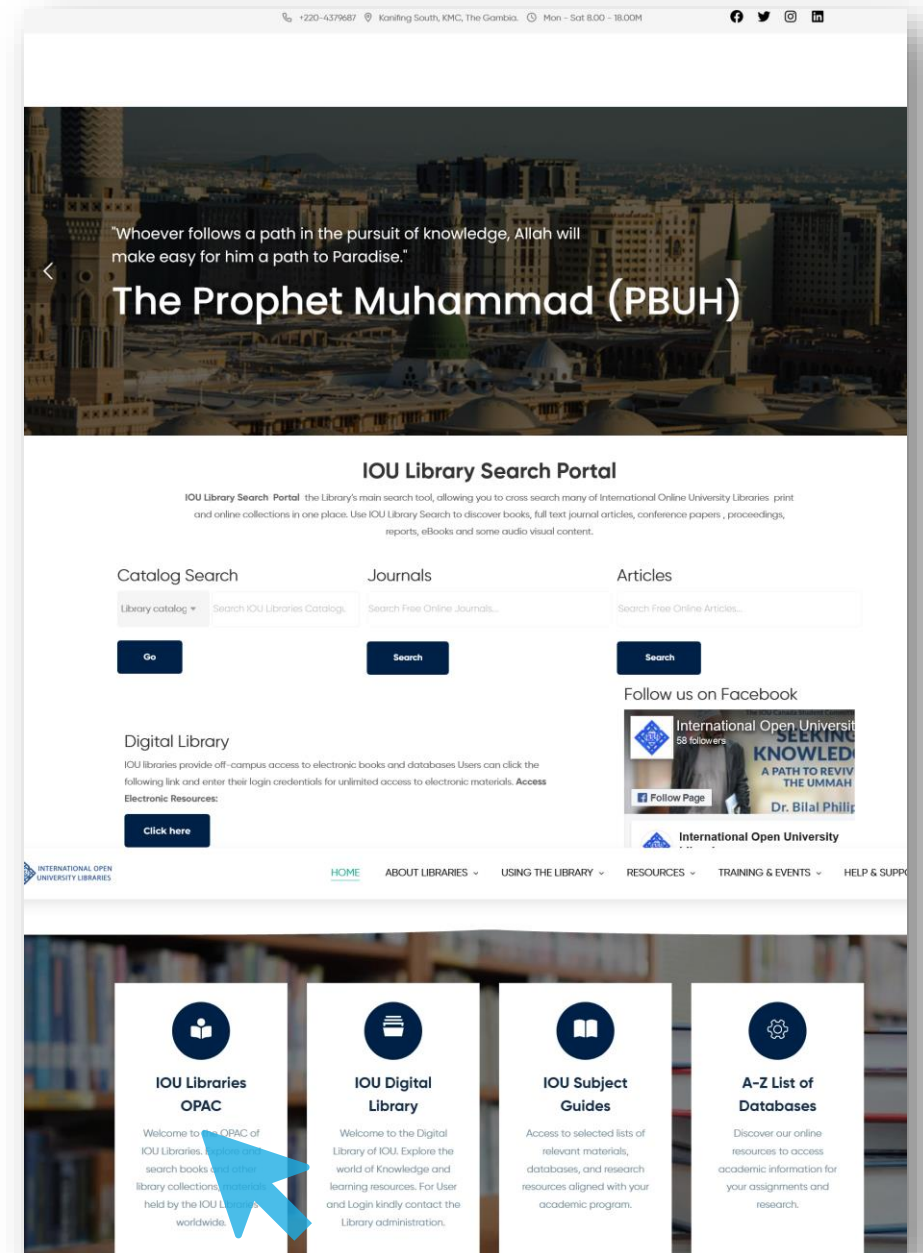


Access The IOU Digital Library

Any user with Internet access can browse, search the IOU Digital Library and view eBooks abstracts without logging in. But once you are a registered user, you will have full access to the content, including the ability to view and download eBook chapters.

1 To get started, type “**IOU Library**” into Google or visit the library website at <https://libraries.iou.edu.gm>

2 Scroll down and click on the box labeled “**IOU Libraries OPAC**”.



3 You will be then directed to the IOU Digital Library page.

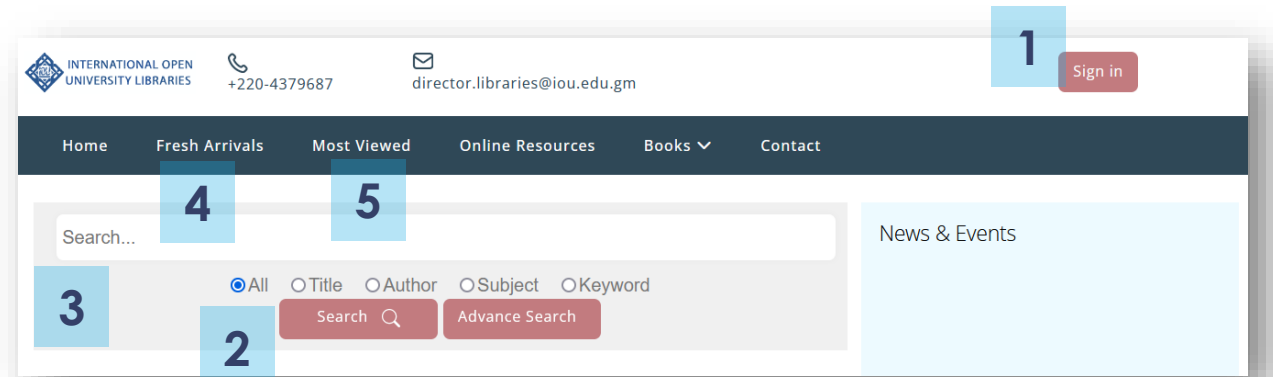




Create an account in the IOU DL


To gain full access to the IOU Digital Library, you need to create an account by following these steps :


4 Click the **“Sign In”** tab located at the top right of the IOU Digital Library homepage. You will then have the option to log in or register if you don't already have an account.


5 To create an account, click on **“Want to Register”**.



If you register with an **iou.edu.gm** email domain, your account will be instantly created, and you will receive a confirmation email containing your username and password.


If you register with a **non iou.edu.gm** email domain (such as Gmail), your account request will undergo verification by the Library team. Upon confirmation of your IOU student status, the account request will be approved




